We are fortunate that this year we have been able to reserve the **Thelma Burns Building** for the "Breakfast" located at **575 Warren Street in Dorchester, Massachusetts on Saturday, June 6, 2026**. Ideal for a temporary location. Further good news is that Dr. Jefferson announced in his recent elaborate inauguration that the "college fiscal status had improved significantly" under his leadership.
